Sturdily built and well equipped

The Toppola Camper owes its success to many factors. The high quality, the high-class workmanship and numerous refinements are merely some of them. The Toppola Camper is very well equipped even in its standard version.



The inspired design will become obvious as soon as you step aboard the Toppola Camper. The "top deck" at the front accommodates the generous double berth (200×170 cm) with ample space even for tall people. Two more berths can be arranged when the back seat of the car is folded down.

The kitchenette section has full standing headroom (200 cm), and the large openable windows make it light and airy. A sink with running water, a drain system with waste water container and a two-ring electronic paraffin cooker are provided at comfortable working height. An adjustable roof ventilator is provided above the kitchenette.



The Toppola Camper has numerous wellarranged stowage compartments for louse objects. A small wardrobe for hanging clothes on hangers is provided right next to the door.



The Toppola Camper is designed for the Nordic climate and can also be used in the winter. The electronic paraffin cooker also serves as a heater, and the walls are well insulated. So the Toppola Camper is cosy in the winter too.



The Toppola Camper in brief

The Toppola Camper is designed for fitting to three-door and five-door Saab 99 and 900 Combi Coupé cars.

Length: 3.3 m (10 ft 10 in)

Maximum width: 1.9 m (6 ft 2.8 in)

Height: 2.0 m (6 ft 6.7 in)

Overall height when fitted to the car: approx. 2.5 m

(8 ft 2.4 in)

Weight: approx. 150 kg (330 lb) (The total increase in weight will be only about 115 kg (250 lb) since the rear door, which weighs 35 kg (77 lb), must be removed when the Toppola is fitted.)

Material: Glass fibre reinforced polyester. Of sandwich construction with Termanto insulation used as spacer material. The outer walls are a total of 20 mm thick (winter insulation). Cabinets and shelves are made of chipboard or plywood and are covered with a tough facing material.

Mountings on the car: 6 roof mountings with reinforcements. The rear mounting is the ordinary striker plate of the rear door.

Electrical system: 12 volt, connected to the ordinary electrical system of the

Internal lighting: 2 bedside lamps

3 lamps in the kitchenette section.

Water: Electric pump with automatic tap. The fresh water tank capacity is 10 litres

Drainage: System connected to a waste water container.

Electronic paraffin cooker (Wallas) with two rings. Also serves as central heating, together with the built-in fan system.

Ventilation: 1 roof ventilator

1 steplessly openable roof hatch with

mosquito netting

2 small openable windows in the upper

bunk section

2 large openable windows in the

kitchenette section

Fitting time: 15—30 minutes.

Optional accessories: Fire extinguisher, steps, kitchen ventilation fan, air conditioner, heavy-duty air springs, mounting stand.

Financing: Eight-year hire-purchase with 20 % deposit to approved buyers.
